



"TOUCH THE CAR"

While I raced my '62 Healey 3000 for 25 years while I lived in Texas, I retired both the car and me from racing in 2014. The reason was that in early 2014, we sold our house in Plano, Tx., furniture, civilian cars, shop equipment, etc., but not the Healey. Jeanice and I then bought a 43' 5th wheel RV, put the Healey in storage north of Dallas, and now we travel throughout North America (subject now to the China Virus restrictions).

We have wintered in Tucson for the past 5 years (Nov 1 – Apr 1). Last Spring (2020), our travel plans had to be completely redone due to the virus restrictions, and thus we didn't leave until Jul 1, for an abbreviated travel in the southwest.

During our extended stay last Spring, I was thinking about what to do with the Healey (in storage in Texas). We rarely get back to Texas, even tho' it is our domicile state – our residence is where-ever we drop the RV's anchor). In discussion with Jeanice, we decided to move the Healey here to Tucson. It was already licensed and insured in Texas (so that I had an official title for the car, and to cover any mishaps away from the track).

I arranged for air-conditioned storage in Tucson, for when we were travelling during the summer. With the Healey now in Tucson, I added working lights, and we started to use the Healey on public roads.

Tucson is surrounded by mountains, and of course desert, so there are some really good Healey roads in the area. One of my favourite drives is up Mount Lemmon in the Santa Catalina mountains – only a 22-mile drive from our RV park in Tucson with a 6800' elevation gain. The Mt Lemmon Scenic Byway is one of the most scenic drives in southeast Arizona. It provides access to a fascinating land of great vistas, outlandish rockscapes, cool mountain forests and deep canyons spilling out onto broad deserts.

Also, another advantage of spending the winter in Tucson, is that the weather is always great (day-time temps typically in the mid-60s to mid-70s, and little to no rain). As a result, there are numerous car-shows almost every weekend. The cars range from numerous hot-rods, custom cars and trucks, plain vanilla street cars, and..... of yeah, and some weirdo with a '62 Austin-Healey 3000 race-car.

I've attended numerous car-shows over the 100 years or so I've been around. Most cars on display typically have signs explaining details/background of the car. Most time there is also a notice saying "Look but don't touch". Now I understand why someone might have this admonishment, however I have a wee bit of a different view. I have a sign that invites folks (especially kids) to touch the car.

The car is a tough Healey race-car, there really isn't anything that can be damaged. Finger prints? So what, that's why God invented soap and car wax. Where else are the youngins' of today going to experience these old cars. I try to keep an eye out for a dad/mom/grand-dad/grand-mom with children looking at the Healey during the car-show. I ask if they (little kids and big kids) would like to sit in the car, and have a family member take a picture.

Last weekend at a car-show at a 50s themed diner here in Tuc-son, an elderly gentleman, somewhere in his late 80s asked if he could sit in the car. His adult son and grandson took pictures - this was really cool. If someone has a big enough grin, I'll ask if they would like to take a ride around the parking lot at the end of the show. Obviously, I have them ask whoever they are with, for permission. Jeanice says I seem to be having as much fun as the kids! Good thing I never grew up.

Hello all you Healey fans!



With all the changes happening in our world these days, I thought it would be worthwhile to communicate with you about our plans for Conclave in Big Bear this May. First, thank you for signing up. 


